Host Guide

Everything you need for a sweet and simple baby shower game.

WHAT YOU NEED

- One game sheet per guest
- Pens or pencils
- The answer key
- Optional candy display and prize

BEFORE THE SHOWER

- Print one guest sheet for each player and one answer key for yourself.
- Decide whether to display the candy bars as visual clues.
- Set aside a candy basket or another small prize for the winner.

HOW TO PLAY

- Give each guest a game sheet and something to write with.
- Set a timer for 5 to 10 minutes.
- Guests write the candy bar that best matches each clue.
- Read the answers aloud and let guests score their own sheets.
- The player with the most correct answers wins.

POSTER BOARD VARIATION

- Attach the candy bars to a sturdy poster board so guests can see their possible choices.
- For a group game, read one clue at a time and award that candy bar to the first person with the correct answer.
